

Procedures

Center Referee

- There are two (2) calls the Center Referee may make to stop a match in progress:
 1. Stop
 2. Out (Out of Bound)

Corner Judge

- There are three (3) calls a Corner Judge may make to inform the Center Referee that they have seen a point or penalty and wish the Center Referee to stop the match in progress so that a judges vote on an exchange between the two (2) fighters can be made:
 1. Point
 2. Penalty
 3. Out (Out of Bounds)
- A Corner Judge seeing a point scored or violation of the “Rules of Play” may ask for the match to be stopped. However, only the Center Referee is allowed to make an official stop a match in progress.
 1. Corner Judges signal the Center Referee of a point scored by a competitor, by calling in a loud voice the word “**POINT**” at which time the Center Referee will stop the match and then call for a judges point vote.
 2. Corner Judges signal the Center Referee of that a competitor has made a rules violation by calling in a loud voice the word “**PENALTY**” at which time the Center Referee will stop the match and then call for a judges penalty vote.
 3. Corner Judges signal the Center Referee that a competitor has gone out of bounds by calling in a loud voice the word “**OUT**”.
- All Corner Judges and Center Referee must cast their votes simultaneously on the Center Referee’s command “**JUDGES CALL**”. Judges who do not simultaneously cast their vote will have their vote voided as to rules (Section V. **Judging Error** rule b)
