

## **When a Judging Official Sees a Point**

At the Center Referee's command of "**JUDGES CALL**" all judging officials will cast their votes simultaneously in one of the following manners:

### **Point is Scored**

The judge holds out to their side the appropriate flag color (or extended arm when flags are not available) on the side of the contestant who he/she feels scored the point.

### **Cannot Confirm**

The Corner Judge holds his/her flags or hands over his/her eyes indicating that he/she could not see whether a technique landed or a point was scored (Same as saying no point).

### **Clash**

The Corner Judge makes a motion as though he/she is hitting both fists together. This means both contestants scored at the same time, therefore no point is to be awarded.

### **Out of Bounds**

The Center Referee calls stop when he/she sees a contestant with both feet out of bounds. If the call for out of bounds is being called by a Corner Judge, he/she will signal the Center Referee by saying in a loud voice the word "**OUT**".

### **Penalty**

If a judging official feels that a rules violation was committed, he/she will point the appropriate colored flag (or make a fist and strike the back of the hand to the open palm of the other towards the offending competitor) of the contestant committing the foul to the ground signifying that the official wants a penalty or disqualification vote. Two (2) penalty flags of the same color require the Center Referee to ask for a penalty vote.
