

Contestants Responsibilities

Once a competitor pays his/her entry fee/fees, it is the contestants' responsibility to be ready for competition when called to do so. Contestant must be suitably attired, and at the designated sign-up area when called and at the appropriate ring when competition begins.

Three calls will be made for division sign-up; a first call, a second call, and a final call.

When a competitor is called for division sign up, the competitor or the competitors stand in must go to the designated sign-up area.

If the contestant or their stand-in is not at his/her designated area for sign-up or competition ring, he/she will be denied entry and contestant forfeits entry fee.

Divisions may be combined in accordance with the three (3) competitor rule as stated in Combining of Division found in the Changing Division section of the rules (Section X).

It is the responsibility of the competitor (if the competitor is a minor) to have their instructor or parent present in the designated sign-up area to help determine which option the competitor wishes to exercise.

If a spokesman for the competitor is not present, the division sign up personnel will ask the competitor which Option he/she wishes to exercise and administrate the option requested by the competitor.

It is the competitors responsibility to thoroughly understand all Rules of Play and Procedures.
