

Warnings and Penalties

A penalty is assessed when a competitor knowingly or unknowingly breaks any of the rules.

The penalties which can be assessed to a competitor are: Warning, The Awarding of a Point to the Offending Competitors Opponent, and Disqualification.

If you are assessed a warning, then your next infraction will result in either: The Awarding of a Point to the Offending Competitors Opponent or Disqualification.

If the result of the first rules infraction is considered by the Center Referee to be severe enough, he/she can omit the first warning and without a vote of judges, award a point to the offending competitors opponent automatically or by a vote of the judges, ask for a disqualification vote.

A point must be awarded to the offending competitors opponent for all infractions after the competitor has received their 1st Warning.
