

Double Elimination Tournament

Double Elimination Single Competitor Fighting Divisions

Competitors are guaranteed two (2) matches.
Competitors compete for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

Double elimination tournaments have a “Winners” and a “Losers” bracket.

If a competitor wins their first match, their name is advanced to the “Winners Bracket”. Each time a competitor in the “Winners Bracket” wins their match, their name is advanced to the next round of the “Winners Bracket”. This process continues until a winner of the “Winners Bracket” has been decided.

When a competitor loses a match, their name is entered into the “Losers Bracket”. Each time a competitor wins their match in the “Losers Bracket” their name is advanced to the next round in the “Losers Bracket”. This process continues until a winner of the “Losers Bracket” is decided. Once you have lost a match in the “Losers Bracket” you have lost two (2) matches and your competition is over and you do not qualify for any further matches.

The winner of the “Losers Bracket” fights the winner of the “Winners Bracket” for 1st Place. However the winner of the “Losers Bracket” must beat the winner of the “Winners Bracket” twice to take 1st place in the division. This is because the winner of the “Winners Bracket” has not lost and is guaranteed 2 losses before their elimination.

If the winner of the “Winners Bracket” beats the winner of the “Losers Bracket” in their first match, the winner of the “Winners Bracket” is declared the 1st place winner and the winner of the “Losers Bracket” will have taken 2nd place in the division. This is because the winner of the “Losers Bracket” has then lost their 2nd match.
