

Starting Over

If a minor competitor under the age of 18 and under the ranking equivalent of Brown Belt starts his/her form over because of a memory lapse or any other reason due to his/her own negligence, he/she may perform again without penalty.

If an adult competitor age 18 & older and under the ranking equivalent of Colored Belt starts his/her form over because of a memory lapse or any other reason due to his/her own negligence, he/she may perform again without penalty.

If an adult competitor age 18 & older with the ranking equivalent of Colored Belt starts his/her form over because of a memory lapse or any other reason due to his/her own negligence, he/she may perform again with penalty.

The Judging Officials will score that competitor as though there was no mistake. After all of the Judges scores have been entered and totaled, the Center Judge will instruct the scorekeeper to deduct 1 full point from the competitors total score.

If a competitor of any age who hold the ranking equivalent of Red/Brown or Black Belt stops their performance during competition due to memory lapse or any other reason due to his/her own negligence will not be allowed to continue and will be disqualified.

Competitor' who qualify to start over can only start over one (1) time.

If a competitor does not finish on the second try, he/she will be disqualified.

If a competitor of any rank has to start over not due to his/her own negligence, the contestant may start over without penalization.
